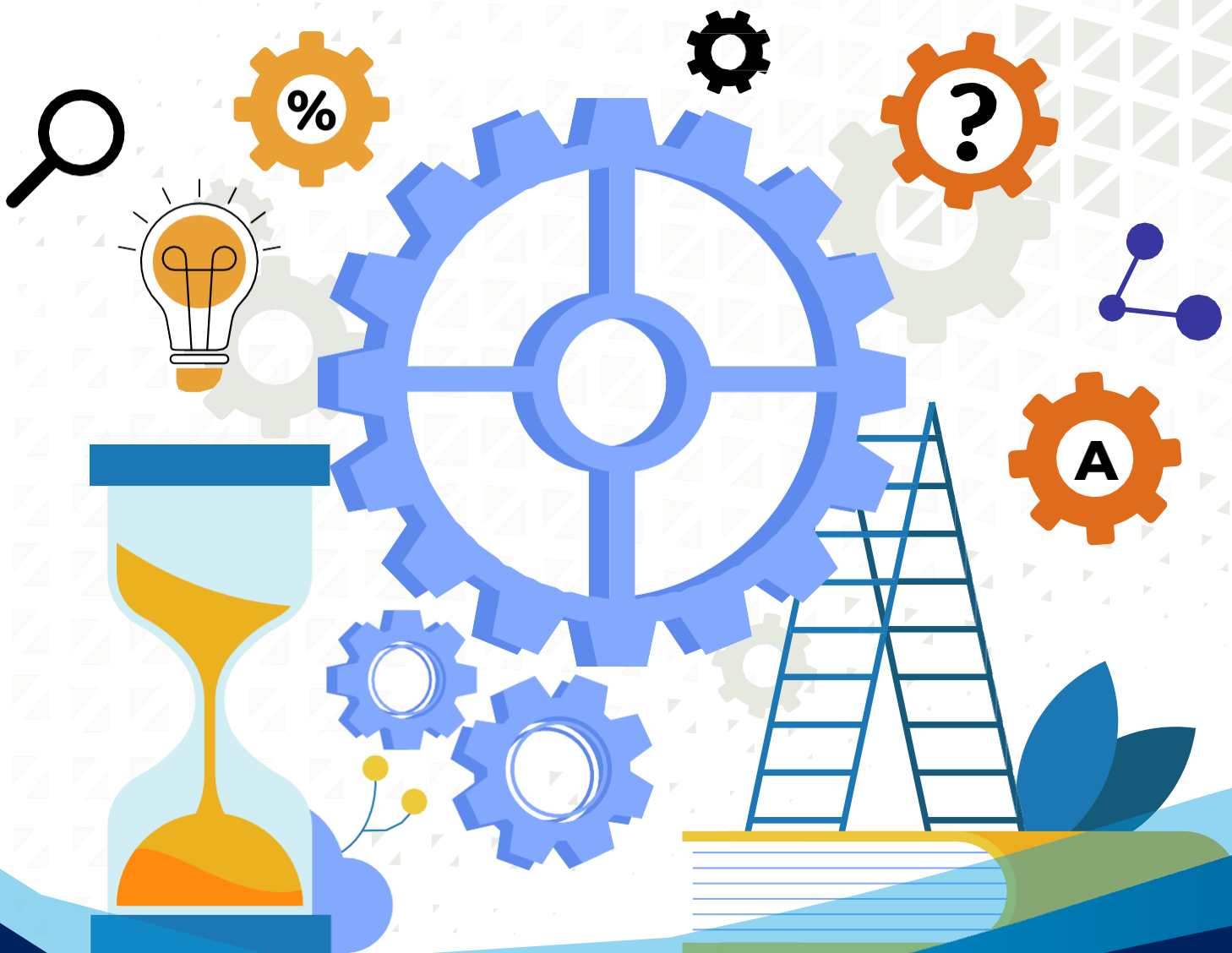

- Students will be assessed byte internship supervisors during the training
- Final evaluation to include seminars, project presentations, and viva-voce, conducted jointly with college representatives

### Implementation Roadmap:

- 1i Signing of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the College and GTTI
- 2i Identification and enrollment of eligible students
- 3i Delivery of internship training via agreed modality
- 4i Issuance of Certificates upon successful completion
- 5i Submission of a completion project report to the college
