

DEPARTMENT OF GEOGRAPHY

Keeping in mind the vast curriculum of the subject the department of geography tries to complete the course with various assessment methods along with the class lectures. There has been a structure provided by the UG BoS based on which the assessments are being taken. The semester examination is based out of 100 marks, of which 10 marks is on the attendance and 10 marks on internal assessment. Remaining 80 marks is divided between practical, which is 30 marks and theory, 50 marks.





To cope up with the syllabus and make students follow the chapters the following mechanism has been practiced in the department to assess the students:

1. Open book test

This helps in analyzing and organizing the answers rather than memorizing it. Helps in identifying reference books and build logical reasoning. Tests are taken on a monthly basis.

2. Surprise viva voce

Question answer sessions are often carried out based on topics taught in previous class. This helps in increasing attention in the class. It encourages students to take class notes.

3. Class discussion

Every lecture is followed by a general discussion regarding the topic taught. This initiates the thinking ability of the students. They have the freedom to express their views regarding the class lecture.

4. Classwork

This is done almost on a regular basis. Students are given questions in the class for practice. Both theory and practical questions are given for practice.

5. Internal Assessment

This is part of the curriculum marked on 10. Exams are taken before the final examination as per university norms.
