Teaching-Learning Method of Commerce Department:

- Assessment and online evaluation was made through Google classroom during pandemic time (2019-2020 & 2020-21): Google classroom provides a centralized hub for resources, assignments and discussions. A variety of content was shared like documents, PPTs, PDFs, etc. Assignments are distributed through instructions, due dates and resources. Google classrooms fostering a more interactive and engaging learning experience that boost-up the confidence level of students.
- Interaction with students was made through Google meet during pandemic time (2019-2020 & 2020-21): Google meet integration allows for virtual class meetings, discussions and synchronous learning experiences. Its interactive features such as polls, raised hands and reaction encourage student engagement and participation during virtual classes. Teachers have shared resources such as PDFs, word files and presentations with students in Google Classroom. These resources can be accessed by students at any time, allowing for self-paced learning. Attendance was also tracked in online classes.
- After pandemic, classes were taken in *blended mode* by focusing mainly on direct teaching method like Chalk and Talk, Smart Classrooms, White Boards.
- At present days, our department solely focusing on class room teaching where students can seek immediate clarification from teachers if they face any difficulties or problems. Classroom teaching facilitate social interaction among students promoting inter-personal skills, teamwork etc. Teachers can also provide individualized attention to those students who may need additional support or guidance.
- Field based learning for finance student: Students were taken to BSE Institute Limited
 for attending seminar on stock market on 07.09.2023 which engages students in
 hands-on experience, gain insights into practical field of study and navigate into realworld issues.
- Industry-academic interface: We collaborate with industries for providing opportunities to students to gain practical experience through internships, seminars, workshops etc. Students benefit from exposure to real-world industry practices and can apply theoretical knowledge in practical settings. Students are placed in companies like HDFC Bank, ITC, Genpact, Punjab National Bank, Technocraft etc.
