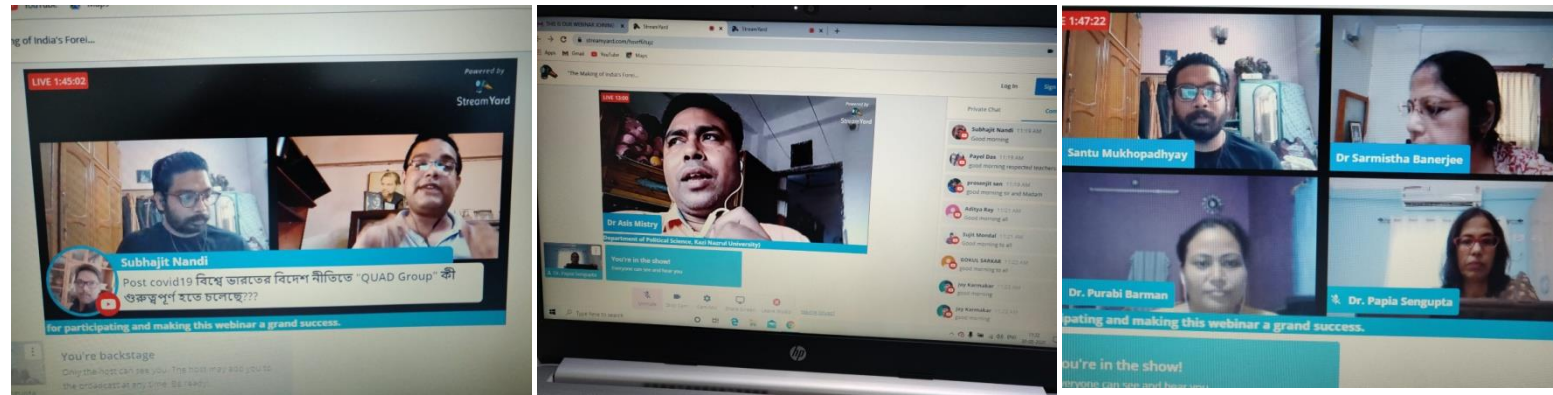
WEBINAR ON 30.08.2020

STUDENTS LECTURE SESSION ON 30.11.2021

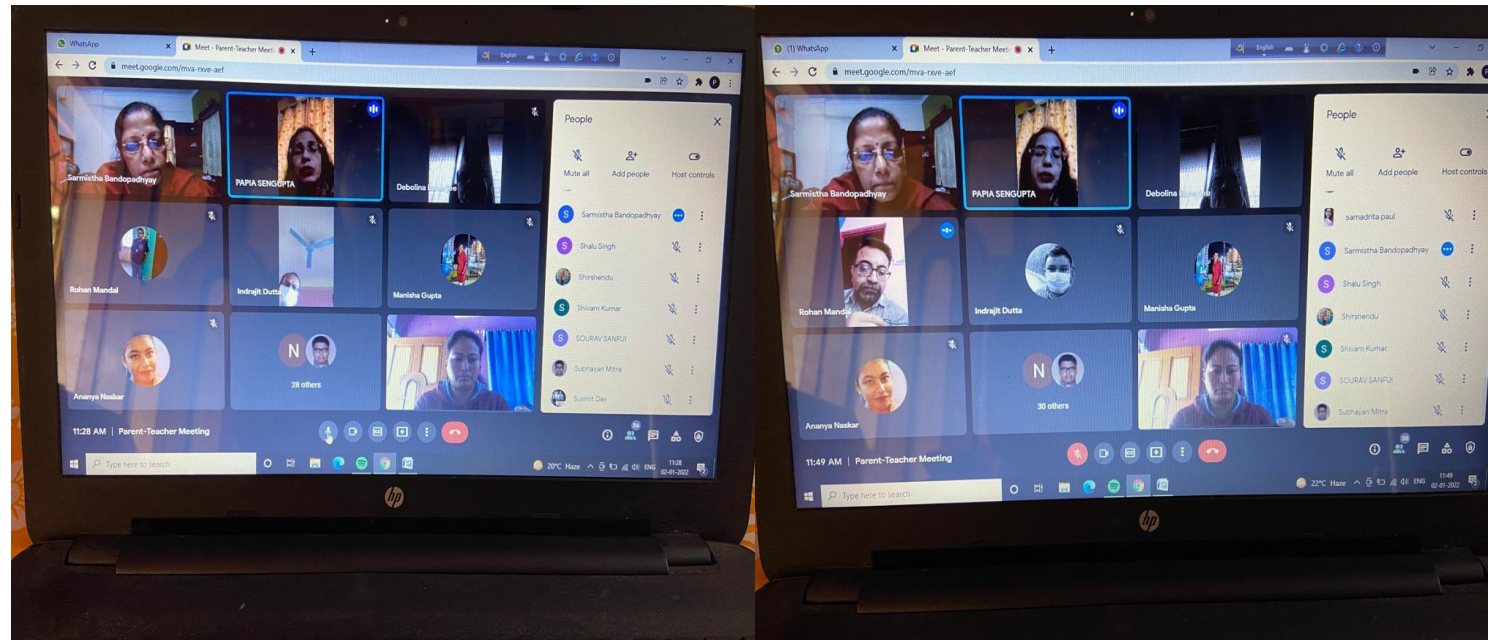

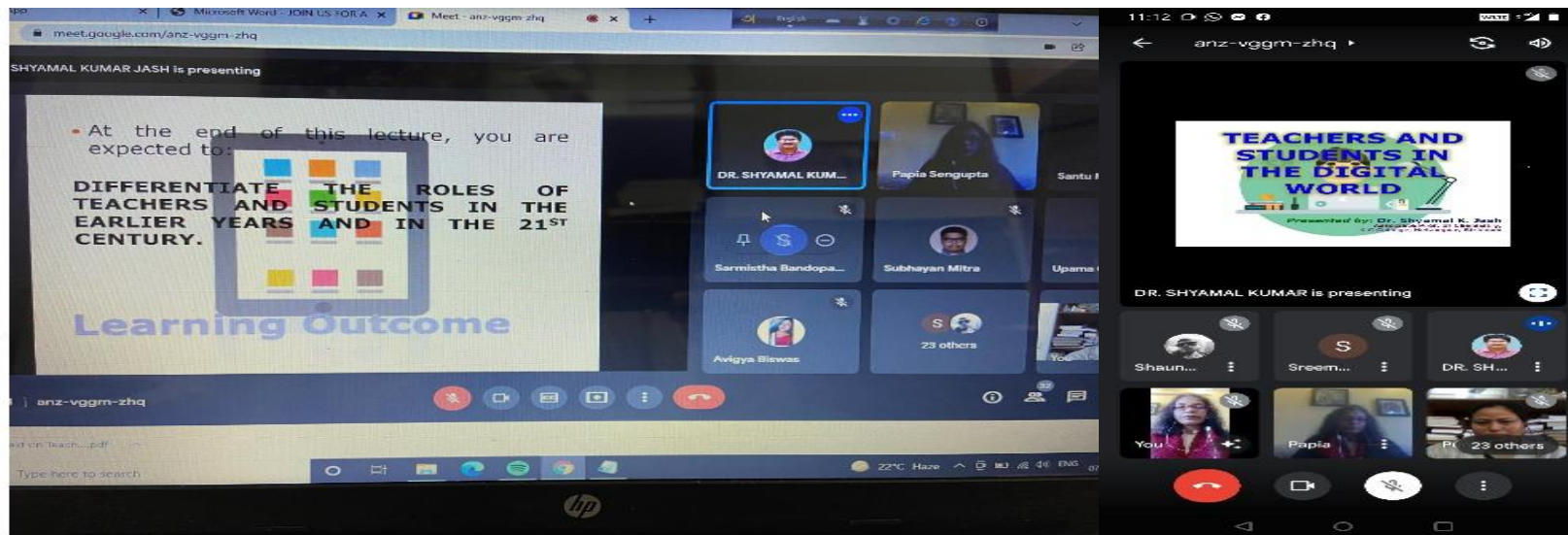

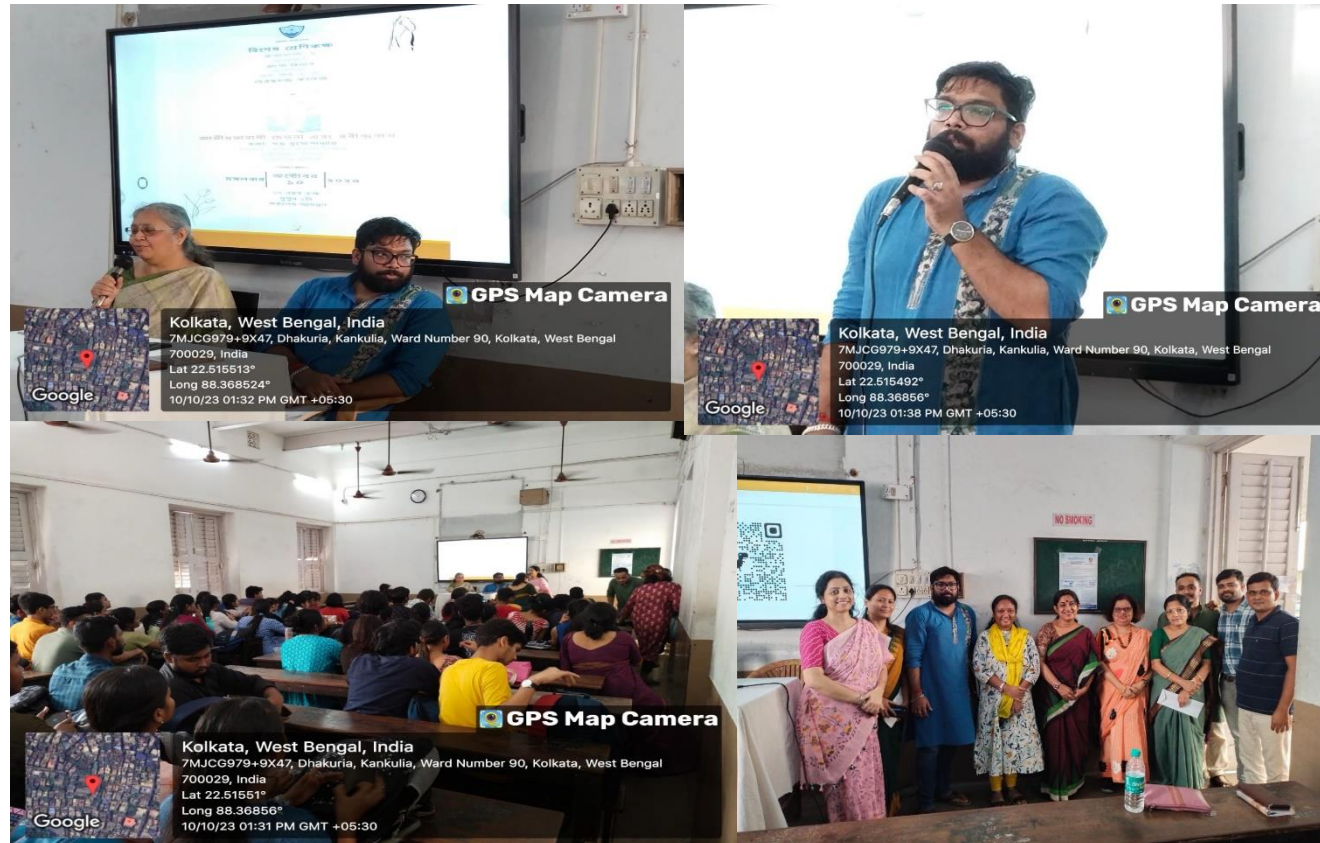
FRESHER'S WELCOME ON 02.12.2022

Dr. Nivedita Saha (Associate Professor, Kalyani University) presided over the event, providing valuable insights and facilitating discussions.

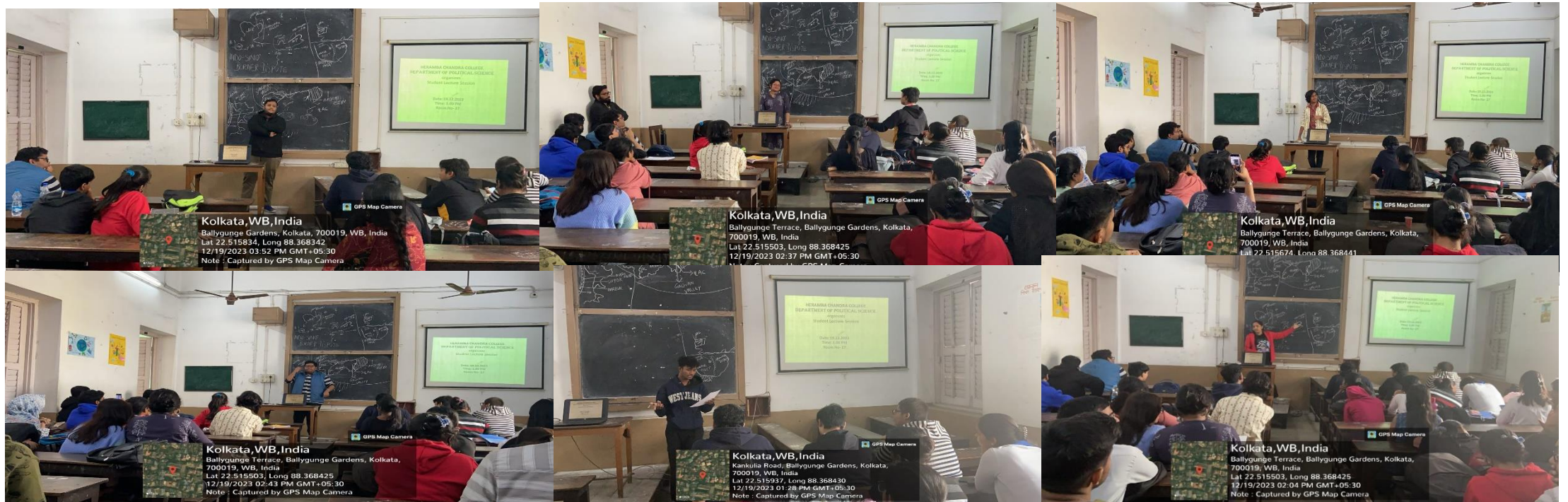
The seminar fostered meaningful dialogue on constitutional values and was well-received by attendees, enhancing their understanding of the importance of the Constitution in shaping democratic society.
